The following instructions are issued for conducting January-2022 Examination.

1. The Time Table should be exhibited in the Notice Board of all the Nursing Schools well in time for the information of the students.

The applications can be uploaded from 14-12-2021 to 27-12-2021 without penalty. There after Rs. 15/- per student per day will be applicable up to 31-12-2021.

- The fees paid once will not be refunded or adjusted to any other fees.
- 2. The Examination fee should be paid through SBI E-payment Option Only.

* NEFT, RTGS, Cheques, DD's & other mode of payment will not be accepted and will be strictly rejected.

For $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ and $\mathbf{2}^{\text{nd}}$ Year Fresh students fees structure is as follows.

First Year 05 Subjects X Rs.300 = Rs.1,500/-

Second Year 07 Subjects X Rs.300 = Rs.2,100/-

For repeaters the examination fees is Rs.300/- per Subject (Theory & Practical Separate)

- 3. All the Principals are informed to issue School ID Badge to all the students for their Identity and they are directed to wear the same during the examination, and also the students and faculty members should be directed to wear white uniform & ID during the examination.
- 4. For academic clarification the Principal or Senior Nursing Tutors should only come to the Examination Board.
- 5. The maximum Internal assessment marks for each Theory paper is 25 marks. The students should score a minimum of 13 marks to pass. Similarly, the maximum Internal Assessment marks for practical is 50 marks. The students should score a minimum of 25 marks to pass. Those who have not scored the minimum pass marks in Internal Assessment is not eligible to write the examination. Internal Assessment Score Sheets for all the Theory and Practical of 1st and 2nd year students including Mental Health Nursing score sheet should be uploaded online only.
- 6. The students should have attended 80% of Theory & Practical classes to appear for the annual Examination.
- 7. External Practical Marks should be uploaded immediately after the completion of each practical examination session wise.

The Principals are hereby directed to compulsorily fill the information as per the below mentioned format and send to KSDNEB via E-mail or Hard copy. Failing which those schools will not be allowed to write the examination. The Principal will be held responsible for any inconvenience caused to the students.
