English Comprehension	To test the candidate's skills in English
Current Affairs	To test the Latest Current Affairs General Knowledge of the candidates. This test will be in the objective (MCQs) formate

Legal Aptitude/ Reasoning	Legal aptitude will consist of problem-based questions to which short answers will be sought. Prior knowledge of the law is not expected. This section will have 10 questions of 5 marks each.
Legal Aptitude/ Reasoning	Current affairs shall consist of one essay of no more than 500 words. Students shall be required to answer one of three options. Applicants will be tested on their knowledge of the issue, the ability to make cogent written arguments and write a well-structured essay. Knowledge of the law is not expected
