TNTET Syllabus

Paper I

- **Child Development and pedagogy** will focus on the Educational Psychology of Teaching and Learning, relevant to the age group of 6 – 11 years.
- The **Language I** will focus on the proficiencies related to the Medium of Instruction. The candidate has to choose any one of the languages (Tamil/ Telugu/ Malayalam/ Kannada/ Urdu).
- **Language II** - English will focus on the elements of language, communication and comprehension abilities.
- **Mathematics and Environmental Studies** will focus on the concepts, problem-solving abilities and pedagogical understanding of these subjects.
- The questions in the TET Paper I will be based on the topics of the prescribed syllabus of the State for Classes I – V but their difficulty level, as well as linkages, will be up to the Secondary Stage.

Paper-II

- **Child Development and Pedagogy** will focus on Educational Psychology of Teaching and Learning, relevant to the age group of 11-14 Years.
- **Language-I** will focus on the proficiencies related to the medium of instruction. The candidate has to choose any one of the languages (Tamil/ Telugu/ Malayalam/ Kannada/ Urdu).

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- **Language II** - English will focus on the elements of language, communication and comprehension abilities.
- **Mathematics and Science/ Social Science** will focus on the concepts. Problem-solving abilities and pedagogical understanding of these subjects.
- The questions in the test Paper-II will be based on the topics of the prescribed syllabus of the State for Classes VI-VIII but their difficulty level, as well as linkages, will be up to the Senior Secondary (Higher Secondary) Stage.
