- [*ADVICE: They can prepare a hard copy first and then fill online to avoid mistakes].
- Candidates should upload their passport size photo and signature in *.jpg or *.jpeg formats within size of 100 kb.
- The candidates shall be considered for admission based on their merit in the caste concerned.
- The Candidates are advised to download their Hall tickets immediately after uploading the online application to appear in written and Physical & Medical Tests.

SELECTION PROCESS

The selection process broadly consists of 3 types of tests viz, Written Examination, Screening Tests (Physical/ personality & Interview / Communication Skills), and finally Medical Fitness Tests.

I. Written Examination

The written examination will consist of 100 multiple answer questions to be answered in 2 hours and 30 minutes. To qualify the Sainik school examination, students need to obtain a minimum of 25% marks in each subject and a minimum of 40% aggregate marks. The distribution of questions is as under:-

Candidates qualifying in the written tests will be called for screening tests (physical, personality) and medical tests in 1:3 ratio in the order of merit as per the merit in the category wise ranking. Incase sufficient number of candidate are not found fit in the first round of screening tests, more candidates may be called in the second round of screening tests in the order of merit. Cut off percentage of 40 may be either raised or lowered based on the performance of the candidates in the written examination.
