General Intelligence and Reasoning:

This section would include questions of both verbal and non-verbal types. It would have questions on analogies, similarities and differences, space visualization, problem-solving, analysis, judgment, decision-making, visual memory, discriminating observation, relation concepts, verbal and figure classification, arithmetical number series, non-verbal series, etc. It will also include questions designed to test the candidate's ability to deal with abstract ideas, symbols and their relationship, arithmetical computation, and numerical Aptitude/ Quantitative Aptitude and other analytical function



Numerical Aptitude:

This section will include questions on problems relating to the number system, computation of whole numbers, decimals, fractions, and relationships between numbers, fundamental arithmetical operations, percentages, Ratios and proportions, averages, interest, profit & loss, discount, time & distance, ratio & time, time & work, etc. General English and Comprehension

General English:

In addition to the testing of candidates' understanding of the English language, this section would include questions relating to its vocabulary, grammar, sentence structure, synonymous, antonyms and correct usage, etc.

General Awareness:

This section would include questions relating to India and its neighboring countries especially pertaining to sports, history, culture, geography, economics scene, general policy including Indian Constitution and scientific research, etc. These questions will be such that they do not require a special study of any discipline Awareness in the relevant trade/field. The test will include questions relating to trade/post, as per the essential qualification specified.
